As you know the City of Brisbane is working on an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Brisbane Baylands. We are in receipt of your comments and have made them apart of the official file.

We anticipate that the draft EIR will be completed sometime later this year. Once the draft is issued I would like to work with you and the BBCAG committee to make the EIR consultants available to the committee. I would anticipate the consultants coming to one of your meetings to go over the report and the proposed mitigation strategies as they pertain to contamination and remediation issue.

The City looks forward to the input of the BBCAG so that contamination and remediation concerns are addressed as the draft report evolves and is eventually submitted to the Planning Commission for review.

Ultimately, the EIR will come to the City Council for certification, and it would be my hope that the BBCAG can thoroughly review the document and provide input, insight and concerns regarding mitigation measures.

It is vitally important that the community feels that adequate and appropriate measures are in place to protect the health and welfare of the site prior to any development.

I look forward to coming to your April 21st meeting and discussing this letter and request with you and your committee.
